About

The Industria Performance Teams are an exclusive, auditioned program designed for students with exceptional talent, ambition and a passion for performance. Participants are carefully selected through a group dance and vocal audition process.

The teams rehearse weekly for 1.5 hours during the school term, where they refine their skills and prepare for a variety of performances throughout the year, including community events, private functions, competitions and a concept video shoot.

The Industria Performance Teams are perfect for students who are dedicated, open to direction and ready to elevate their dance and vocal abilities in a dynamic, supportive environment.

Auditions

FRIDAY 28TH NOVEMBER @ INDUSTRIA PERFORMING ARTS

- 8-12 years | 4:30-5:30pm
- 13-17 years | 5:30-6:30pm
- 18-25 years | 6:30-7:30pm

Please note that students may be asked to stay for the next session if we determine it is necessary during the audition process.

What to Expect:

Students will learn a short dance combination and perform it in small groups.

They will then sing the audition song, also in small groups. The song will be emailed to auditionees a week before auditions.

What to Bring:

Water, comfortable clothes you can move in, jazz shoes, good sportsmanship and a smile!

Outcomes and Next Steps

- Audition outcomes will be emailed by 10th December 2025.

Successful Applicants

- Classes for successful applicants begin the week of 2nd February 2026.
- Enrol into performance team. A deposit will be required to secure your spot.
- Performance team members and parents will sign an agreement outlining commitment and expectations.

Unsuccessful Applicants

Students who are not selected for the Performance Team will still have valuable opportunities to grow, improve and perform. We are introducing both foundational and elite extension, invite only, programs designed to support strong, ongoing skill development. They may also be considered for solo competition entries or invited to participate in larger performances if additional performers are required. We encourage all students to enrol in regular classes to continue building their technique and gaining experience. Individual feedback is available to help guide their progress and prepare them for future auditions.

Performance Team Expectations

INDUSTRIA CORE VALUES

Performance Team members are expected to uphold Industria's four core values of community, respect, love and self-confidence. As role models within the company, team members must maintain a high standard of behaviour both in class and at external performances and events.

TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

To ensure the high standard of our Performance Teams, members are required to participate in a:

- Weekly Performance Team Class
- Weekly Jazz Class
- Weekly Vocals Class
- ***NEW*** Foundation or Elite Extension Program - a focused, fortnightly 1.5/2-hour session Friday afternoons/evenings. This class is designed to strengthen foundations, refine skills and give performers dedicated time to elevate their technical ability in a supportive, high-level environment. Allocation to Foundation or Elite will be determined based on each student's current skill level, ensuring they receive the training that best supports their growth and development.

ATTENDANCE

Consistent and punctual attendance is crucial for team cohesion and success. Performance Team students are expected to:

- Attend all scheduled classes and performances, arriving on time.
- Provide prior written notice to Industria for absences due to illness, family emergencies or compulsory school events.
- Understand that birthday parties, holidays or non-urgent matters are not valid excuses for missing class or rehearsal.

PRACTICE

Students are required to practice outside of class time. Industria will provide practice videos for each routine (sent via WhatsApp group), which must be used for rehearsal at home. A minimum of 10 minutes of daily practice is expected to ensure readiness for performances and competitions. Consistent practice is essential for the success of the team.

ORGANISATION/PREPERATION

Class:

- Students must wear black/white dance wear or Industria branded clothing.
- Correct footwear must be worn to every class.
- Staying hydrated with a water bottle and fueling your body with proper food is essential.

Performance:

- Students must arrive fully prepared with hair and makeup complete.
- Correct costumes, accessories, shoes and tights must be brought to performances.

EFFORT AND WORK ETHIC

Performance Team members are expected to give 100% effort in every class. This includes:

- Staying focused and engaged throughout lessons.
- Taking corrections and feedback positively and applying them effectively.
- Pushing themselves to improve technique, stamina, and performance quality.
- Maintaining a strong work ethic, even when learning challenging material.

Being part of the Performance Team is a privilege, and students must demonstrate commitment, discipline, and a drive for excellence in every class.

Performances

Along with our end of year concert, Industria Performance Teams participate in various events throughout the year, including:

- Community performances
- Private functions
- Concept Video Shoot
- Industria's Vocal Showcase



COMPETITIONS

While competitions are often viewed as competitive events, they can serve various purposes beyond just competition. At Industria, we aim to give our students performance opportunities that help them gain experience and achieve personal goals. Competitors also receive feedback from qualified adjudicators, who can identify areas of improvement and provide guidance for future development. If we earn a placing at the competition, that is just an added bonus, not our primary focus.

In 2026, we will be participating in:

- *On Stage Performing Arts Competition* (September 26th - October 2nd)
- Solo, duo, and trio opportunities available throughout entirety of the year, upon request.

Costs Involved

- Performance Team Term Fee: **\$285 per term.**
- Foundation/Elite Extension Program
- Performance Team Tracksuit (to be worn to performances): estimated between **\$100-\$120.**
- Competition Registration Fees: typically **\$35 per competition.**
- Additional Costumes: We aim to keep these costs as low as possible.
- Shoes: Black and tan jazz shoes. In addition, older students may need to purchase chorus heels.
